- **Research** - Monitor industry news and market changes and incorporate this into data and written analysis. Additionally, research and create new datasets to support our global data, news, research, and analysis services.

- **Natural gas industry expertise** - Familiarity with the North American natural gas market, including drivers of supply, demand and pricing. Interact regularly with market data sources. Identify and support client needs through research, analysis and client interaction with relevant data and analysis.
